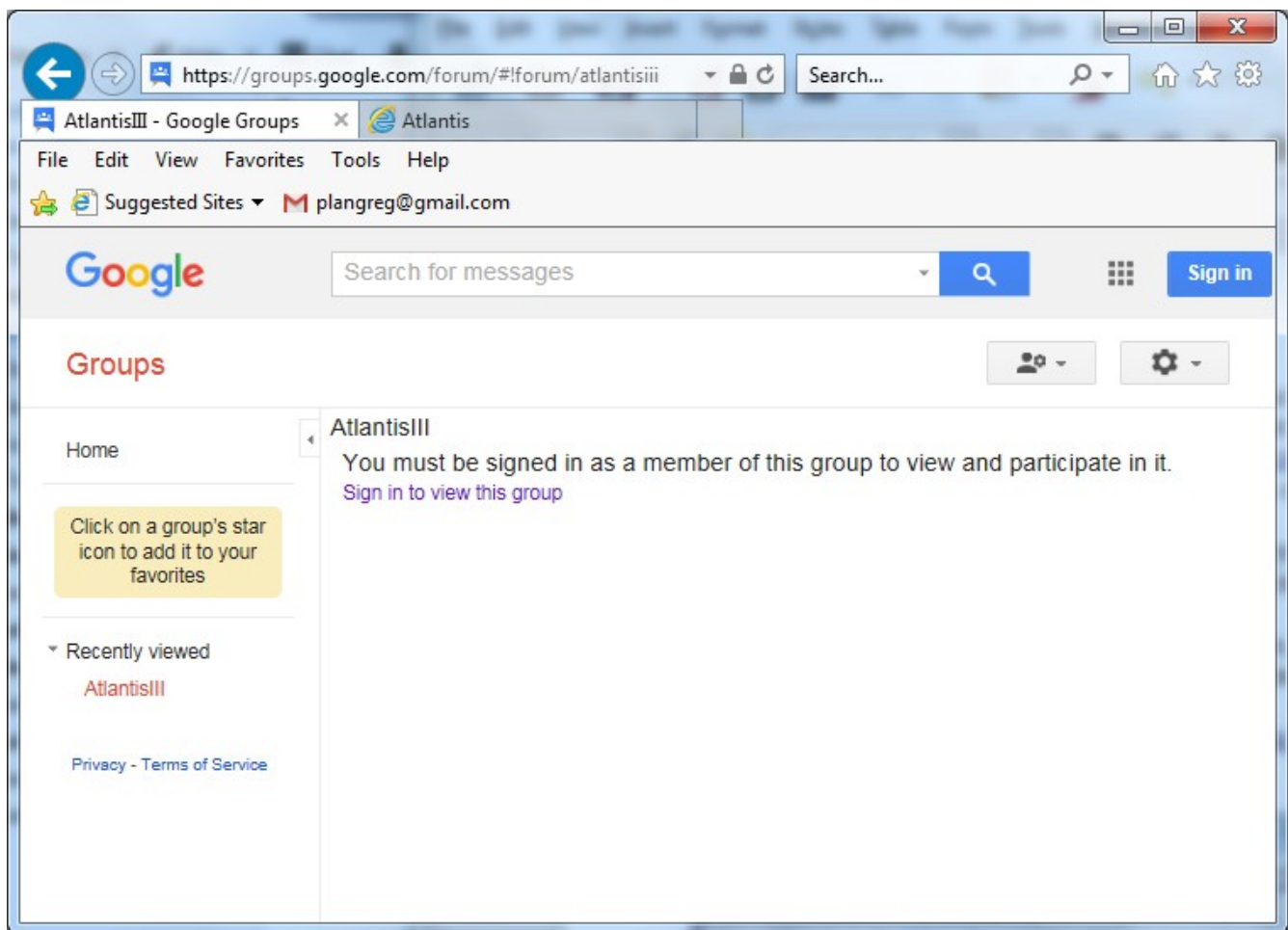


Some people have said that they don't want to create a Google account to follow the Atlantis III group discussion. You don't need to create a Google account (or even have a Gmail account to follow). Just send an email to atlantisiii+subscribe@googlegroups.com and you will be subscribed. Or, just email me and I can subscribe you without any further action on your part.

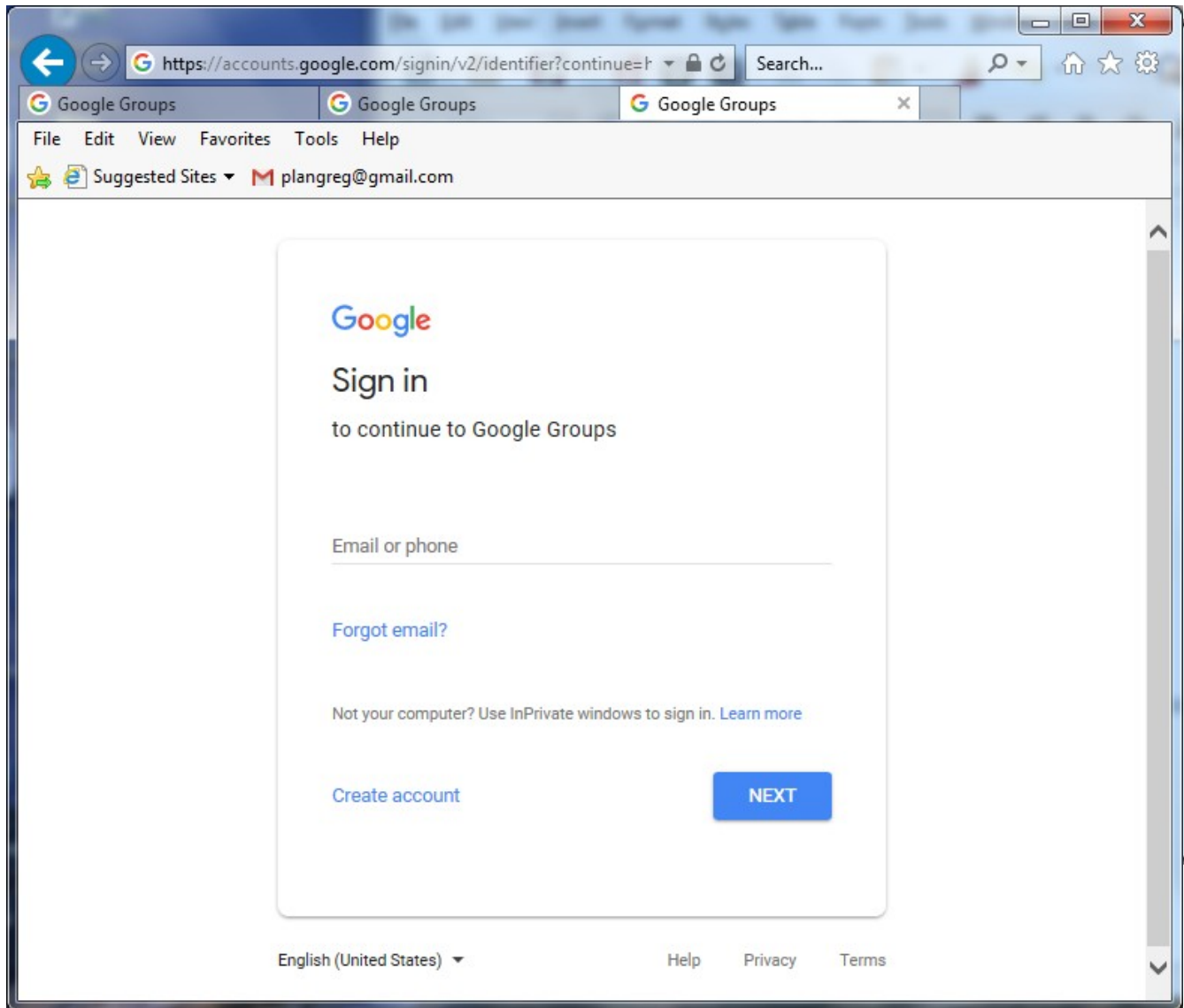
However, if you want to read the archived messages, you will need to create a Google account. This DOES NOT mean that you need to create a Gmail account – you can use your favorite email address.

In the example below, I have put together a few screen grabs showing the process. Remember, you only need to follow this process if you want to view the archives – it is optional!

First, go to: <https://groups.google.com/forum/#!forum/atlantisiii> and you will see the following screen. When you see this screen, click on the link that says: Sign in to view this group



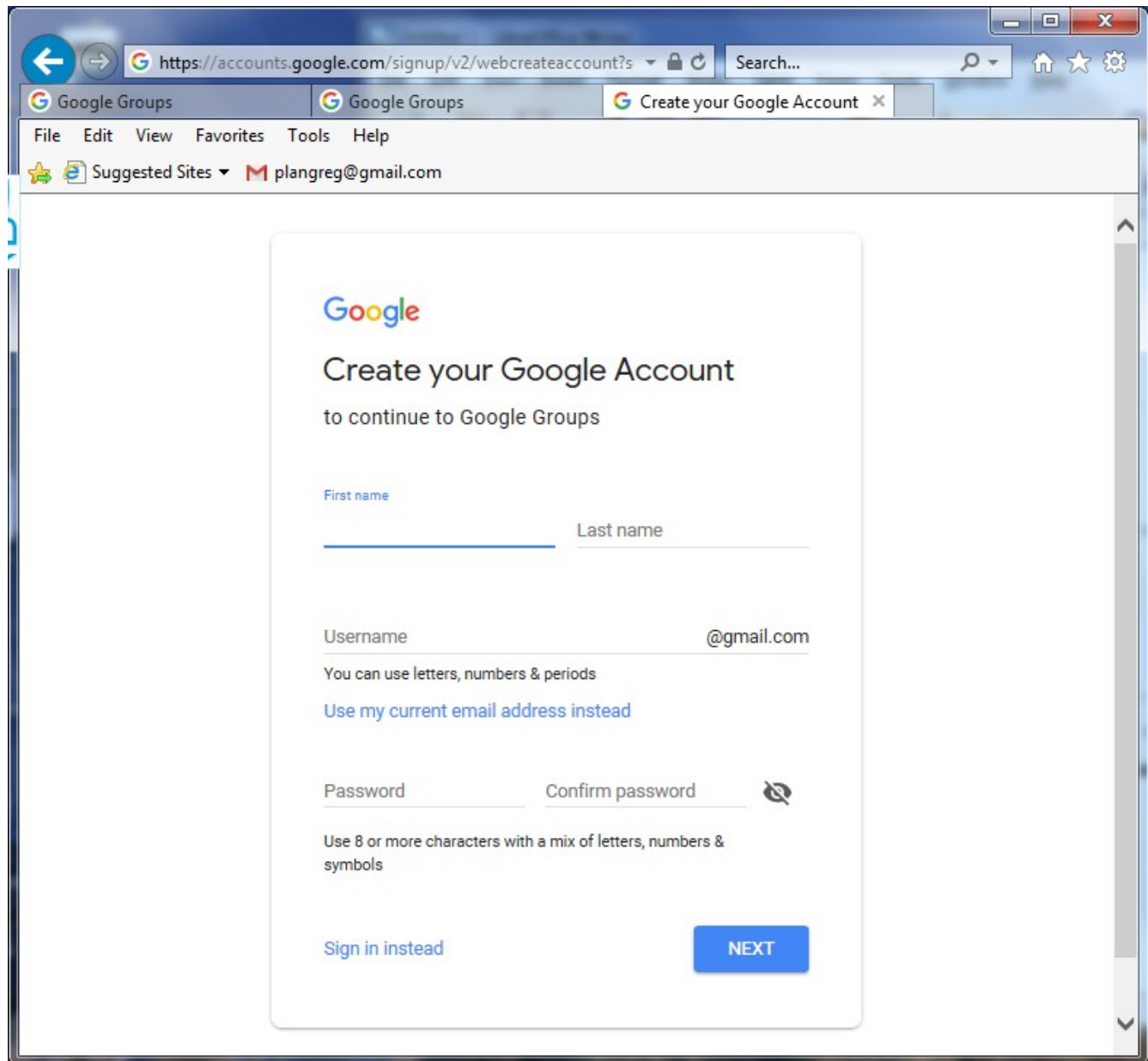
If you have a Google account, you can sign in here,
OR
Click on “Create account”



Now you can create a Gmail account

OR

You can create a Google account using your non-Google email address. In this example, I will be creating an account for Jimmy Buffett with a non-Google email address. So I am going to click on the link that says: Use my current email address instead



Now just fill in a few fields, First Name (Jimmy), Last Name (Buffett), email address (JBuffett@AtlantisCondos.org) and the password twice.

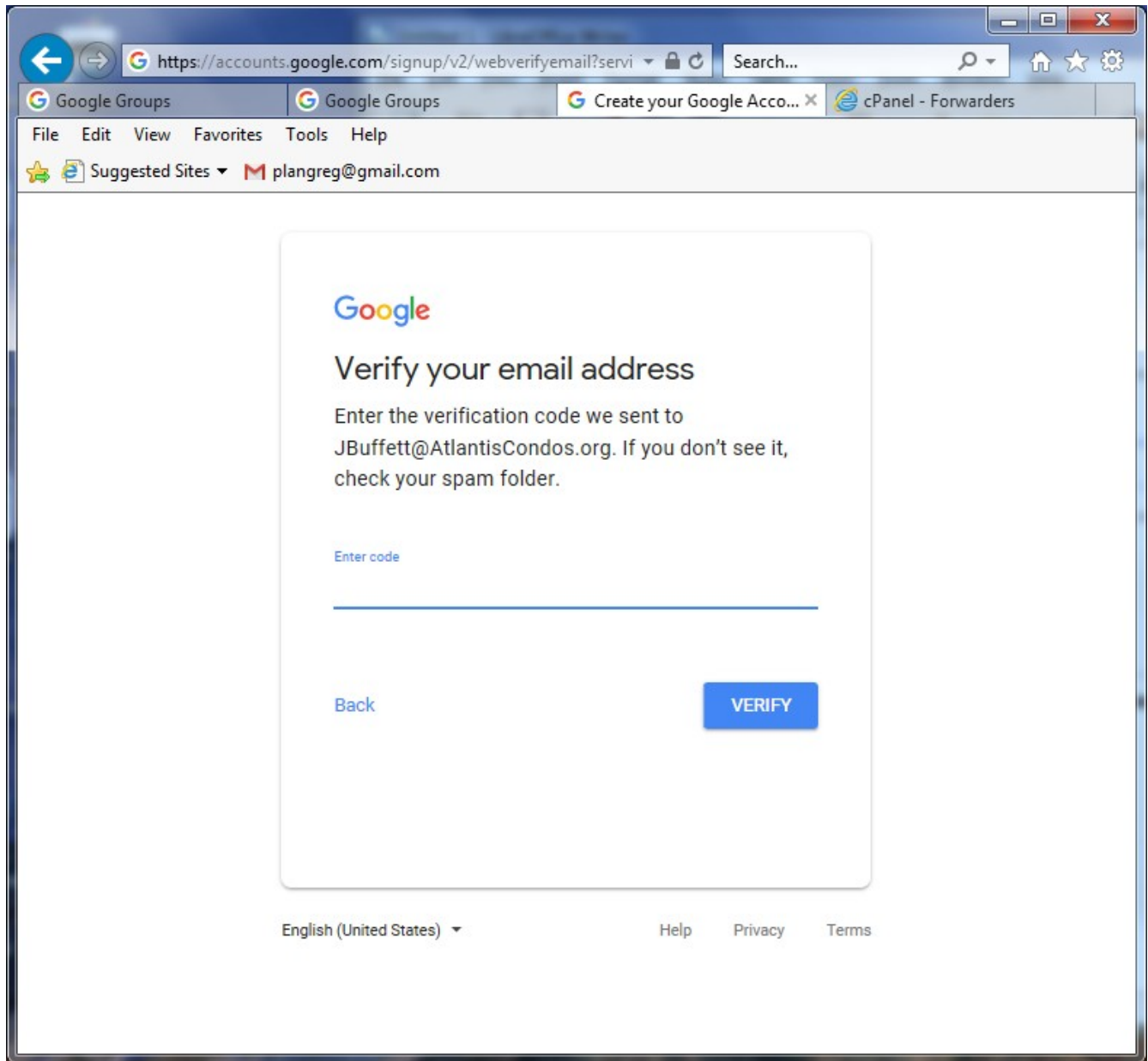

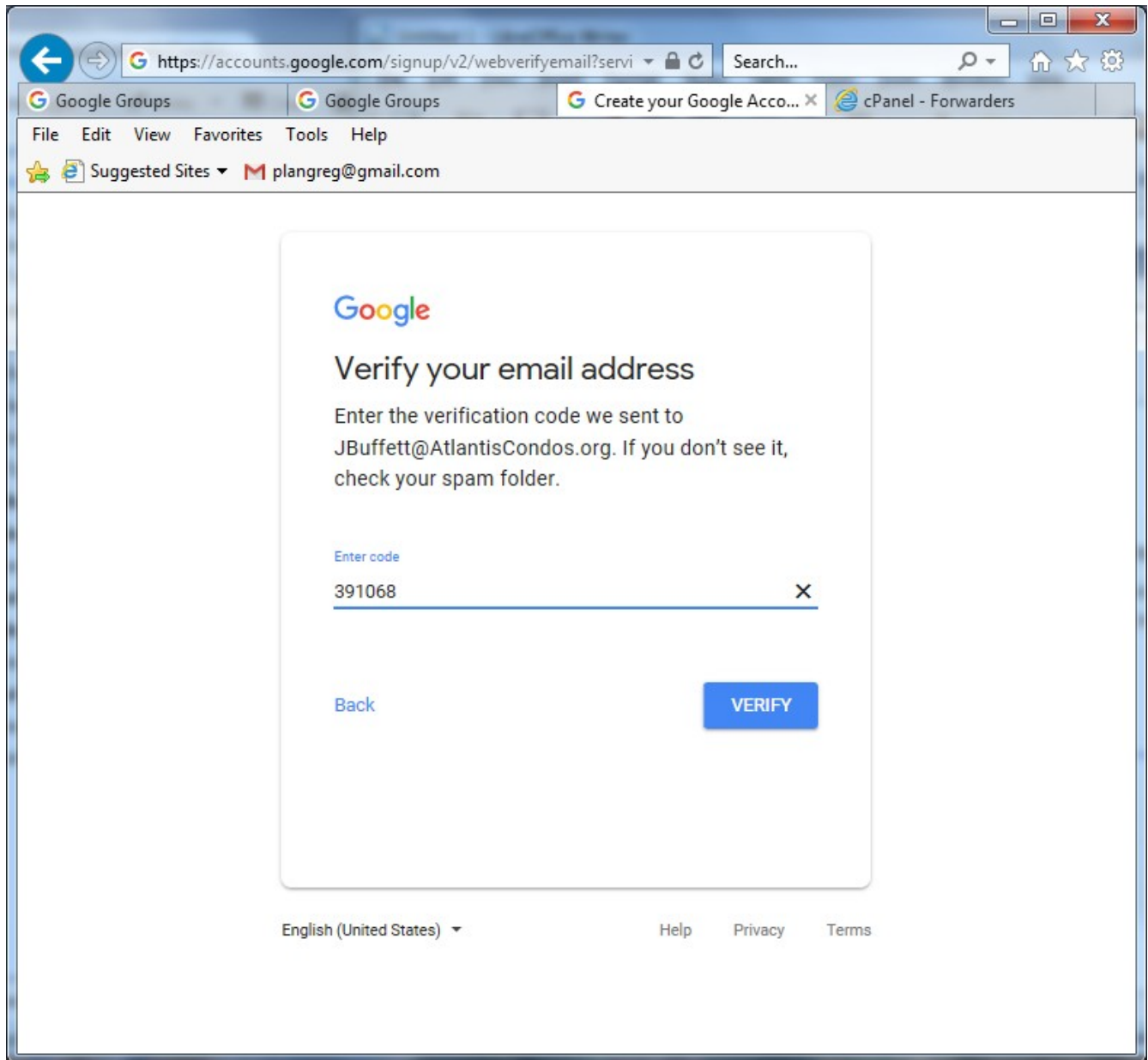

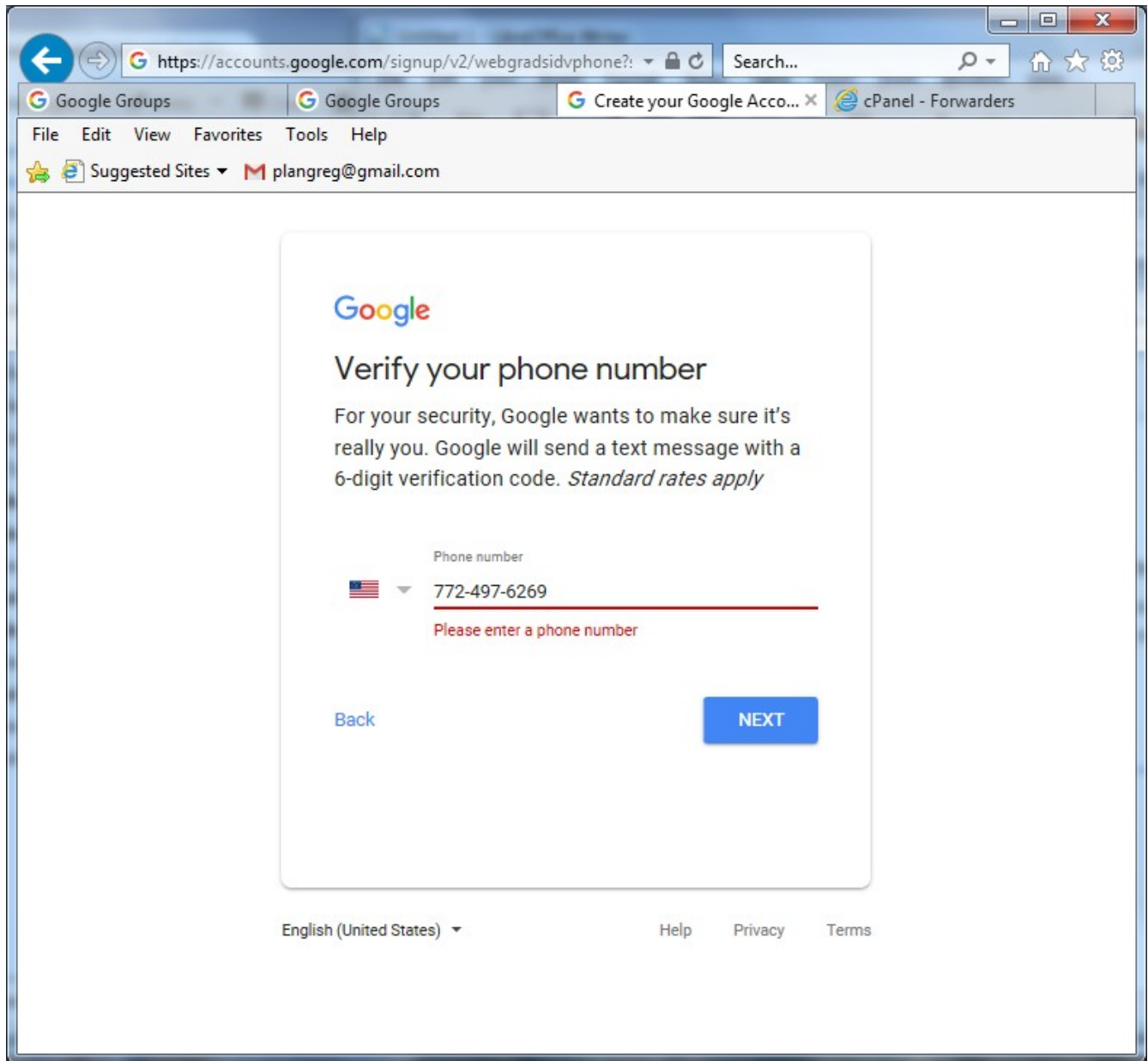
After you click the “Next” button, the following screen will appear. Google will want to confirm your email address by emailing you a 6 digit code and asking you to enter it on this screen.



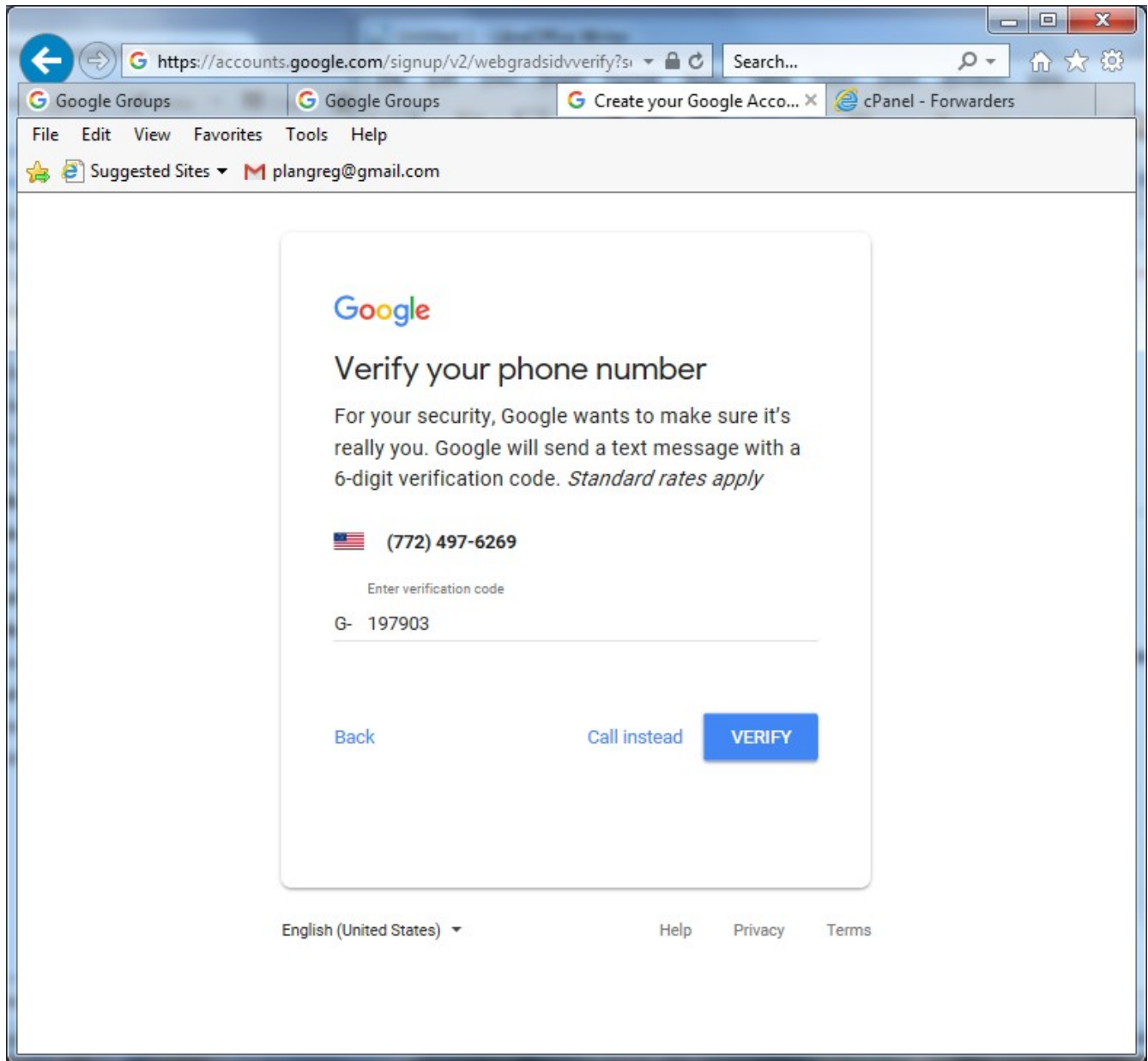
I waited for the email to arrive and then I entered the 6 digit code then clicked the “Verify” button.




Next, Google wants to verify your phone number. You will need to enter a cell phone number and good will send you a text message with a 6 digit code.



Once again, I waited to receive the text message with my 6 digit code and I entered in the screen below, then clicked the “Verify” button.



Google then wants some personal information. If you are concerned about sharing personal information like this, you don't have to put in the real information. Then click "Next"

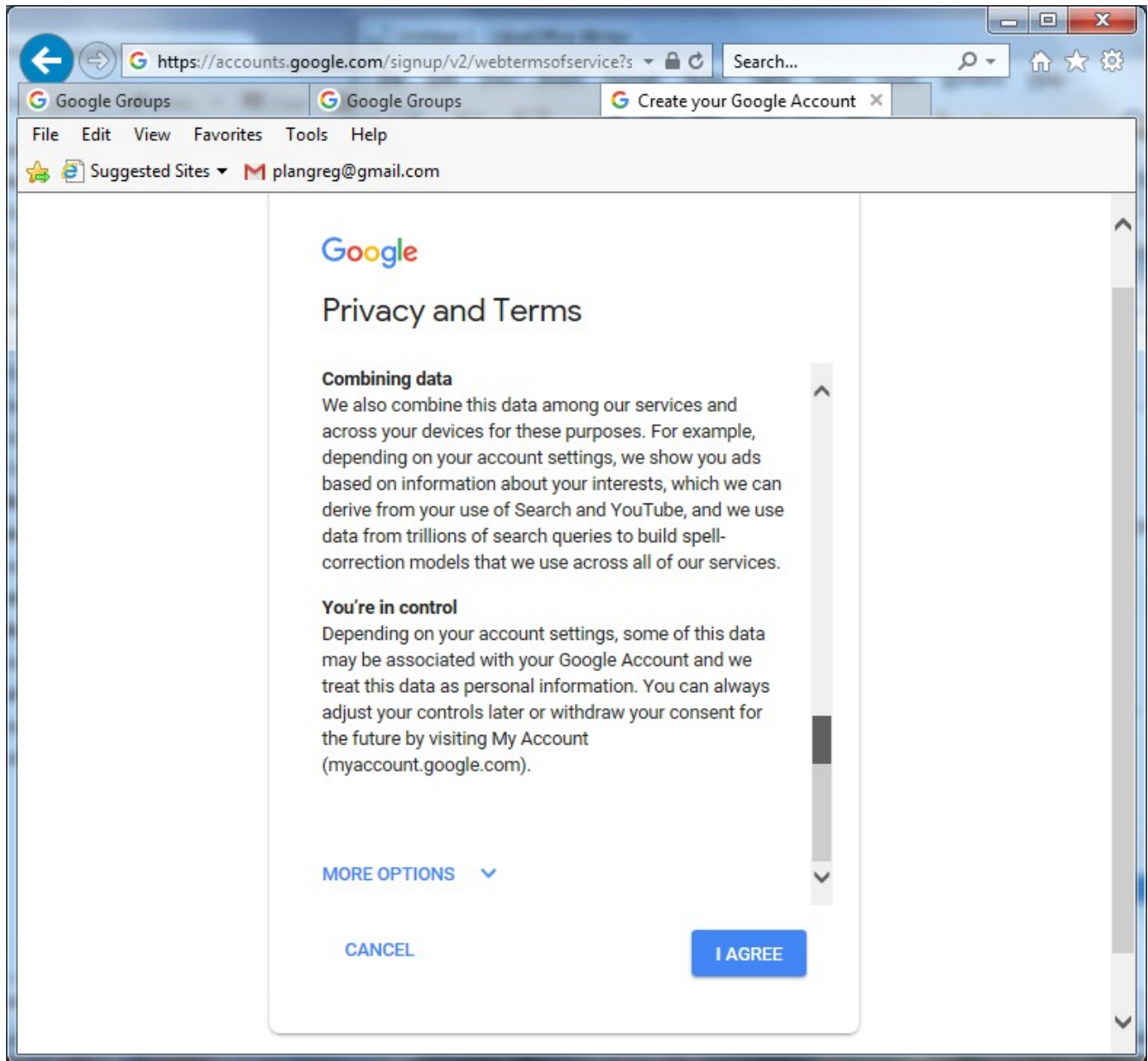

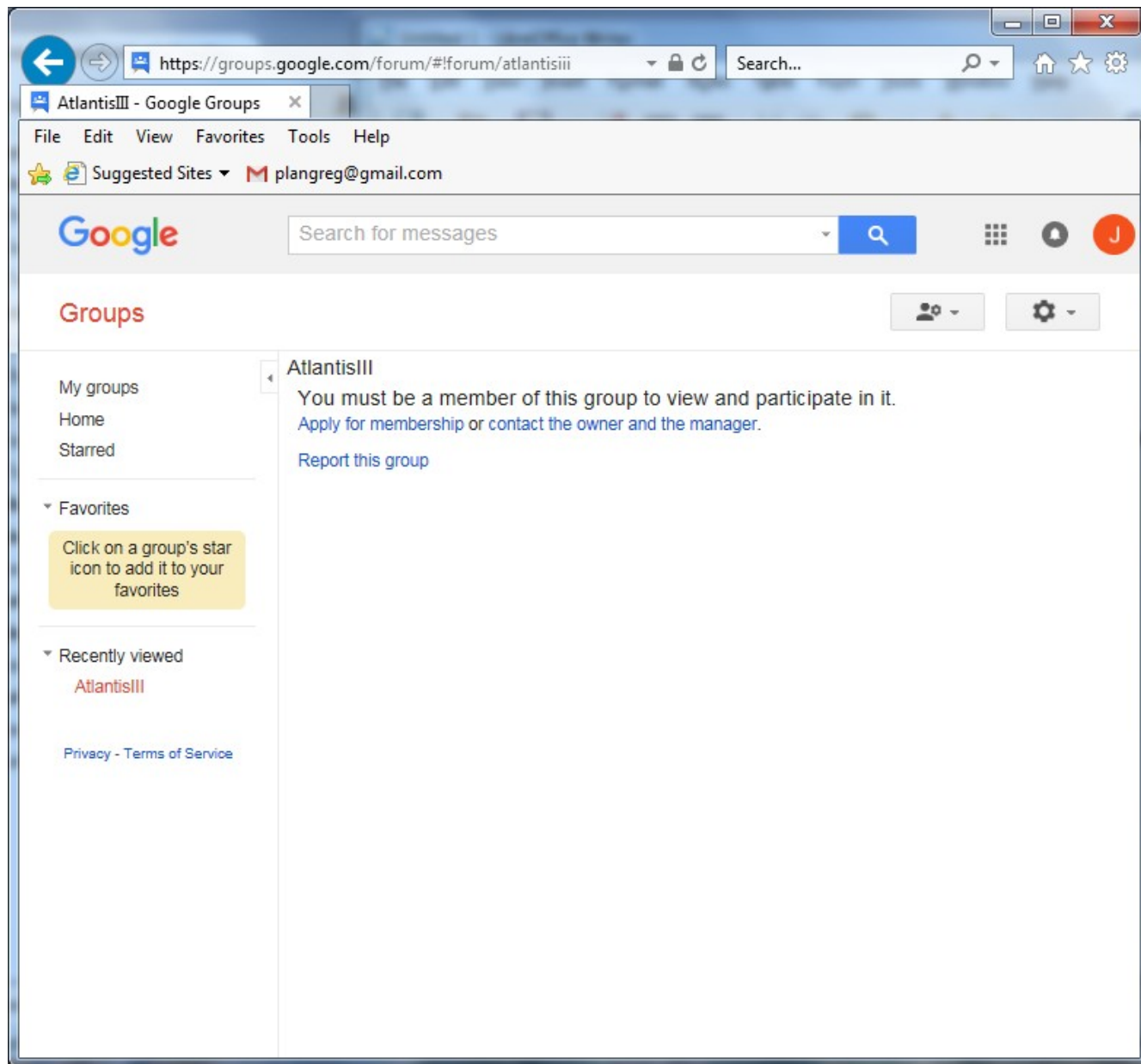
Back NEXT

Next, Google wants your agreement to their privacy terms. Scroll to the bottom so that the bottom of the privacy terms message so that the “I agree” button appears, then click that button.

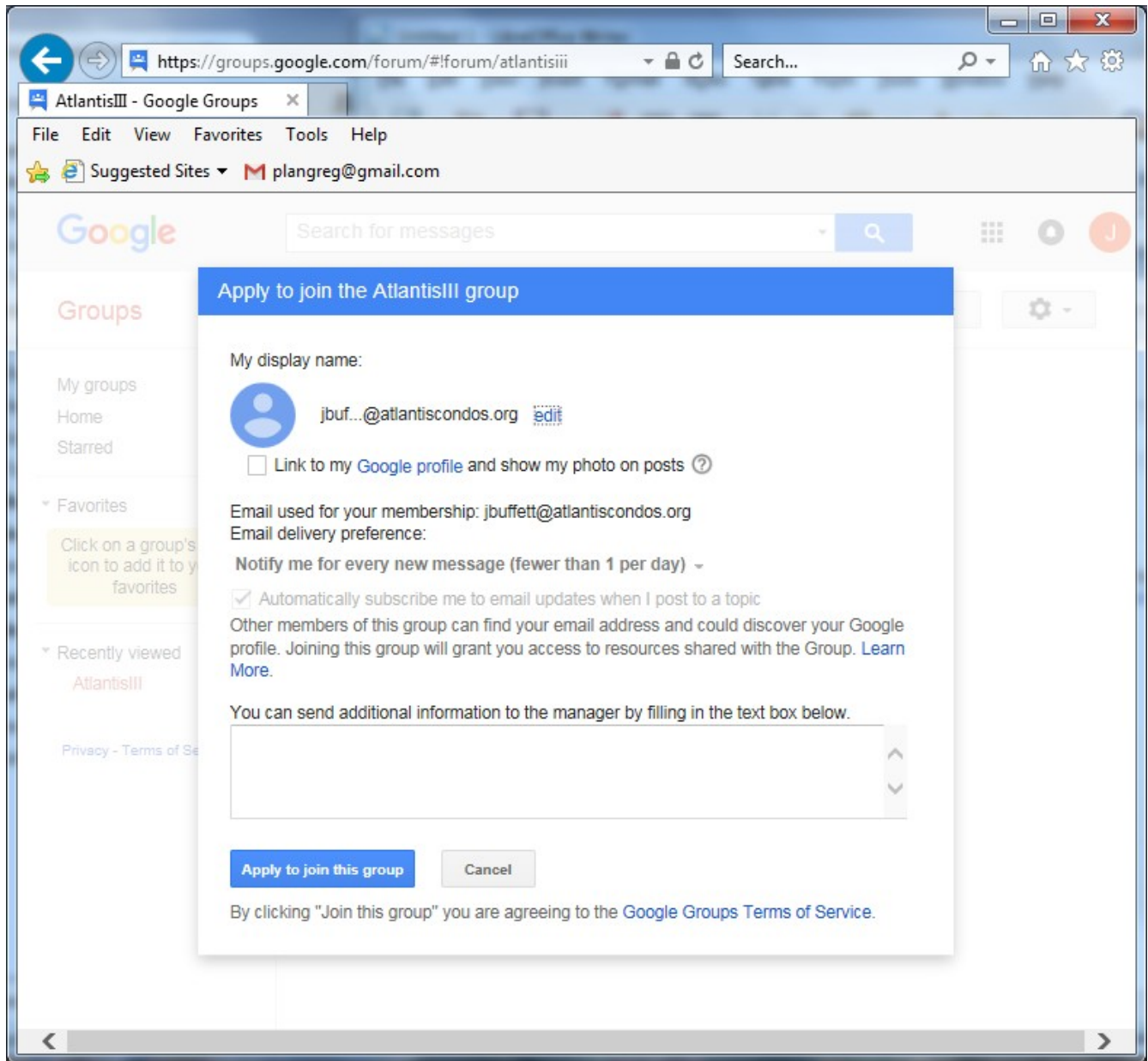


At this point, your Google account has been created!

Whether your email address is already subscribed or not, you will still get this screen and still need to send another join request by clicking on “Apply for membership”



Once you've clicked on "Apply for membership" you will get this screen. You can fill in the information if you want, or you can just click the button that says: Apply to join this group.



And you are done!

This screen will be displayed. You will have access once one of the group managers (right now, I am the only person managing the list, but if somebody else wants to help, let me know) approves the request.
